

CREATIVES CAMP

Camp Dates: June 4-7 ~ 2D Art (Painting & Drawing)
June 10-14 ~ 3D Art 1 (Sculpture)
June 17-21 ~ 3D Art 2 (Sculpture)

Camp Times: 9am-12:00pm (Drop-off starts at 8:30am)

Session: Ages 6-12; June 24-June 28

Spend each week exploring and learning all about how to create works of art, using the Garden as the inspiration. Campers will develop an understanding for the techniques used in creating paintings, drawings and sculptures. They will learn some of the history behind why artists have chosen to express themselves with the creative process. Additionally, using various hands-on activities, campers will use the techniques they learned to create and will produce their own work of art.

Activities will include things such as:

- Watercolor painting using the garden as inspiration (Plein Aire)
- Molding and modeling using different media to make sculpture
- Drawing from live subjects
- Perspective and composition

NATURE DETECTIVES

Camp activities: 9am-12:00pm (Drop-off starts at 8:30am)

Session: Ages 6-12; June 25-June 28

Spend a week exploring and learning all about plants, animals, and life in the Garden. Campers will develop an understanding for the natural world and how everything works together while getting their hands dirty in various hands-on activities. Learn about different animals, adaptations and habitats. You will get to know some critters up close through various activities.

Activities will include things such as:

- Investigating animal tracks and signs
- Dissecting seeds
- Plant projects and experiments
- Nature hikes and games

Camp is \$50 per week, per student and includes all that is required for camp. Campers should dress in comfortable clothes. Creative Campers should be in clothes that can get paint or other media on them. Science campers should have clothes that can get dirty. All should wear closed-toe shoes (no sandals or flip flops).

1. Please bring a refillable bottle for water.
2. A snack will be given halfway through each day of camp. Please inform instructors of allergies.
3. Please arrive on time to pick up your child. Children become anxious when parents are not there at end of camp. If you are going to be late- please inform the instructor as soon as possible. Instructors will give information on reaching them at the start of camp.
